Activities

Mechanisms

records available to all
members in real-time

Less information silos or multiple ledgers: a singular decentralised & distributed ledger in place

Avail under one umbrella: medical history, consultation details, prescriptions.

Through a mobile application Patients: have real-time access and control of their medical records.

Outcomes

Accurate medical diagnosis and treatments, with less no information silos or data blind spots.
